WHAT is happening?

In accordance with the site Odour Management Plan, Seafield WwTW site operators, Veolia, will be undertaking planned cleaning work in the grit removal units. The decision has been taken to carry out the work now due to a long period where weather conditions have not been favourable. Grit removal is an important part of the preliminary treatment process, as it protects equipment from increased wear and premature and unplanned failure of assets. The work has been reviewed through an Odour Risk Assessment process and notified by Veolia to Scottish Water and regulators.

WHY are we telling you?

As part of our ongoing commitment to minimise any inconvenience associated with the operation of the treatment works, we recognise the need to maintain open communication with our neighbours.

WHEN is this happening?

This is work will commence overnight on Tuesday 21st May and will continue until Friday 24th May. Work will then continue the work the following week, Tuesday 28th until Friday 31st May.
