
Did you know that there were restrictions on the amount of water you could use in June?



What is your experience with water shortage like this year?







- 'The water from my tap is pleasant to drink, pressure is good, and the service is reliable'


Those who responded 'Ok':







Which option best describes your water and waste service connection?





